



LEGISLATIVE SESSION RECAP



Land Use - SB23-213

Bill Summary: The bill would make broad changes to how the state approaches housing development. It prioritizes high-growth areas located near public transit and removes local regulatory barriers to increasing housing supply. It also restricts municipalities from prohibiting certain types of developments and expands the ability of landowners to build accessory dwelling units and multiplexes.





Property tax - SB23-303

Bill Summary: The Colorado General Assembly passed a bill that would ask voters to approve a 10-year property tax relief plan to combat skyrocketing home values and backfill lost revenue for local governments.





Air quality - HB23-1294

Bill Summary: HB 1294 requires pollution modeling simulations for several categories of permits, including any indirect air pollution sources that are determined to be large indirect air pollution sources of ozone precursor pollutants. The bill also requires state regulatory agencies to consider the cumulative impact of all sources of emissions at new oil and gas drilling sites.





Fair Workweek - HB23-1118

Bill Summary: The bill imposes requirements for certain types of employers, with regard to: The determination of employee work schedules; Employee requests for changes to work schedules; and Notices and posting of employee work schedules.
